


### Crazy weird science

## GOD TOOK CARE OF BABY MOSES CRAFT



### You will need

A small paper plate, the picture of baby Moses, green paper, wool or string, something to colour with, scissors, glue or sticky tape, a hole punch.

1. Colour in the picture of baby Moses in the basket on the river and stick it in the middle of the paper plate. Write the words, *God took care of Moses. He takes care of me too.*



2. Punch 2 holes in the top of the paper plate. Thread the wool through the holes and tie it together, so you can hang it up.

3. Use the green paper to trace around your hands. Cut out the shape of your hands.



4. When you stick the hands on, don't put glue on the whole hand, just glue or sticky tape a strip along the bottom. Then you will be able to fold the hands back, and see baby Moses hiding behind the plants along the river. You could even add the princess and Miriam in the background if you want to.
