**Crazy weird science** On Ignite Kids Online this week, Alison did an experiment that made an egg go rubbery. Here is how to do that at home. Make sure you have your parent's permission first!

You will need

1 egg, white vinegar, a cup or container

What to do

Gently put your egg in the bottom of the container. Make sure the shell doesn't crack! Completely cover it with vinegar.

Leave it for 24 hours. Don't touch it, or take it out of the vinegar.

After 24 hours, lift the egg out of the vinegar. Warning: It might feel slippery and slimy, and it could be a bit messy, so have some paper towel or a cloth handy. The shell will start to dissolve.

The egg will be rubbery, but inside it is still runny (don't bounce it on the floor!)


There is also a **creative activity** for you to do this week. If you get it done by Wednesday night, bring it to the Zoom meeting and show everyone your awesome creativity!
